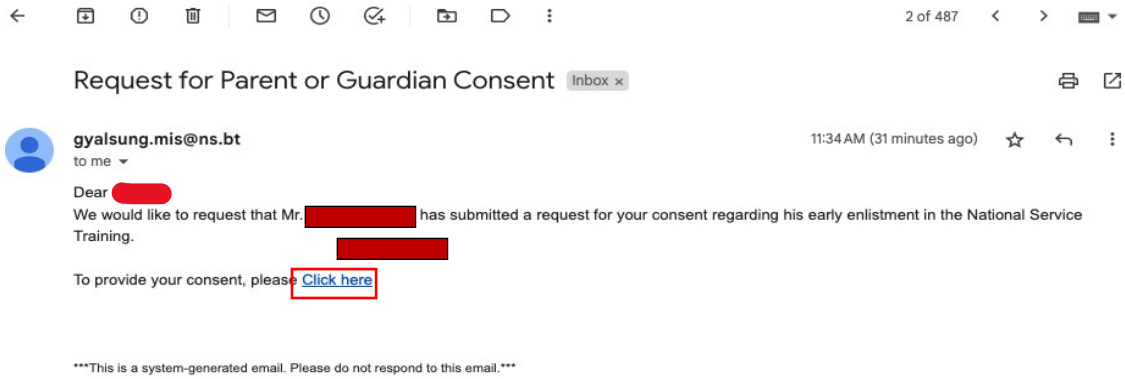


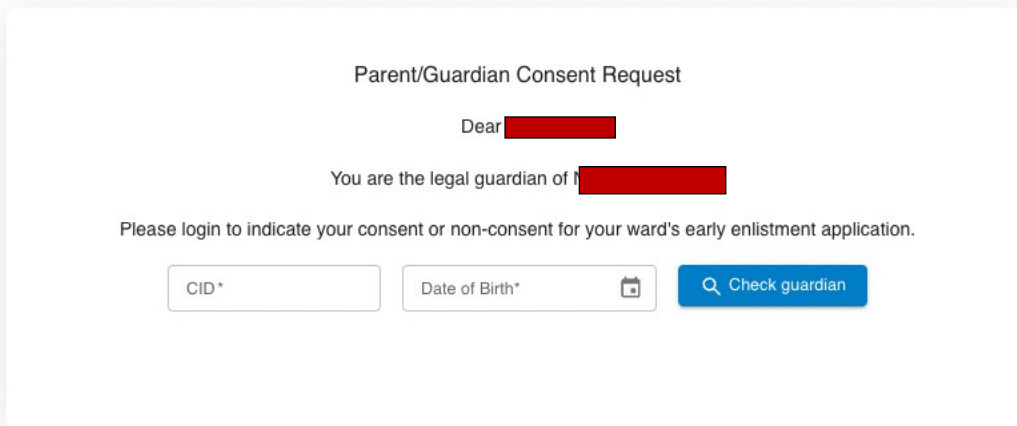
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GUARDIAN CONSENT

The primary guardian will receive a link in SMS and email to grant or deny the early enlistment application for his/her ward's Gyalsung training.



Step 1: The guardian needs to open the link via SMS or email by clicking the “Click here” hyperlink.



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Step 2: The guardian needs to enter their CID and date of birth to validate.

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

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR VOLUNTARY EARLY ENLISTMENT

1. Under the Gyalsung Act of the Kingdom of Bhutan, 2022, a Bhutanese who attains the age of eighteen years shall be required to enlist for Gyalsung Training. However, notwithstanding this general age criterion, Section 14 of the Act permits a person below the age of eighteen years but above the age of sixteen years and six months to volunteer for early registration
2. The voluntary Early Enlistment provision for Gyalsung Training shall, unless the Gyalsung Headquarters specifies otherwise through amendment of the existing laws, be provided to only such persons who are below the age of eighteen years but above the age of sixteen years and six months on 1st January of the year of intended early enlistment and who have completed Class Twelve or equivalent.
3. The Gyalsung Headquarters shall accept an Application Form for Voluntary Early Enlistment only when accompanied by a duly filled Consent Form of the applicant's genuine parent or guardian. Providing such consent through the prescribed form entails that the parent or guardian accepts to subject his or her child or ward to Gyalsung's Act, Rules and Regulations, Code of Conduct and Orders or Instructions that may be passed by the authorities from time to time.
4. Persons who volunteer to enlist early will be put through a medical and mental fitness examination and an aptitude assessment to ascertain whether they can cope with training. Each application will be decided on a case-by-case basis by the Headquarters.
5. The Gyalsung Headquarters reserves the power to enlist a person applying for early enlistment into Gyalsung Training and in doing so it may consider factors such as the training capacity after taking in eligible persons who have attained 18 years of age.
6. The persons volunteering for early enlistment shall be required to register through Online Early Enlistment Portal provided by the Gyalsung Management Information System (GMIS).
7. The persons enlisted through the Early Enlistment provision will undergo the same training and

Step 5: Once you accept the legal terms and conditions, the “Not Support” and “Support” buttons will be enabled. Click the “Support” button to grant consent. A confirmation pop-up will appear. On clicking the “Yes, Sure” button, you grant your son or daughter permission to enroll in Gyalsung Training.
