The Gyalsung Headquarters is pleased to announce the launch of the Gyalsup for Gyalsung (GFG) program as a part of the National Service Duty (NSD). This program is a vital part of our mission to contribute meaningfully to the Nation-Building process.

Overview of Gyalsup for Gyalsung (GFG)

The Gyalsup for Gyalsung (GFG) program is a part of the National Service Duty (NSD) and is aimed at mobilizing Gyalsups, mainly, to contribute to the ongoing construction and maintenance work at the Gyalsung Academies. These academies, located in different regions of Bhutan, are at the heart of the Gyalsung National Service program. By participating in this GFG program, Gyalsups will play a key role in ensuring the success of Gyalsung Academies, helping to build infrastructure and contribute to national development.

The GFG program is based on the existing Desuung for Gyalsung (DFG) program at the Gyalsung Academies and most of the modalities of recruitment and deployment are similar, including the remuneration and benefits.

Selection Criteria

1. Candidates must be a holder of certificate of the completion of National Service Training.
2. Preference will be given to candidates who have participated in 117th National Day celebration and associated activities.
3. Candidates must be willing to perform a variety of tasks across different work areas, demonstrating flexibility in their roles.
4. Candidates must not have any existing health problems that would affect their ability to work.
5. Candidates must demonstrate a strong sense of discipline and adhere to high standards of work ethics.
6. Candidates must be committed to working for a minimum of 3 months.
7. Candidates must be prepared to work in any adverse weather conditions, including extreme heat or cold.

- Candidates who plan to pursue further studies during the work period will not be considered for selection.
 - Selection will be on a **first come, first served** basis. As slots are limited, early application shall be considered.

Withdrawal from the GFG program

- Once a Gyalsup volunteer for the GFG program and is selected by the Gyalsung Headquarters (GHQ), they cannot withdraw without a valid reason.
- A Gyalsup seeking withdrawal for legitimate reasons must adhere to the established procedures, and such withdrawal will not have any adverse consequences.
- Any Gyalsup who withdraws without a valid reason will be disqualified from all GHQ-organized opportunities for one year from the date of withdrawal.
